FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST (FOI 2013-01446)

This letter is our final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated August 7, 2013. In that letter you requested information regarding Contract No. DE-AC27-01RV14136. Specifically, you requested the following information as stated below:

1. The executed HSSA for this contract;
2. Employer Compliance Agreement and Signature Sheets for all contractors performing work on the above referenced contract as governed by the "Site Stabilization Agreement for All Construction Work for the U.S. Department of Energy at the Hanford Site" (HSSA) and the incorporated "River Protection Water Treatment Plant – Addendums to the Hanford Site Stabilization Agreement" (RPP-WTP);
3. Employer Compliance Agreement and Signature Sheets for all contractors performing offsite fabrication on the above referenced contract as governed by the "Site Stabilization Agreement for All Construction Work for the U.S. Department of Energy at the Hanford Site" (HSSA) and the incorporated "River Protection Water Treatment Plant – Addendums to the Hanford Site Stabilization Agreement" (RPP-WTP).

In an electronic message dated September 19, 2013, you agreed to pay estimated fees as provided to you on September 18, 2013.

Your request was assigned to Bechtel National Inc. (BNI), and the U.S. Department of Energy, Richland Operations Office (RL), Contractor Industrial Relations office, the offices that would most likely have responsive documents.
