Request description

Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. Â§ 552, I request access to and (copies of any records of security breaches at United States Nuclear Weapons facilities, including but not limited to, Los Alamos, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratories, Sandia National Laboratory, Nevada National Security Site, the Pantex Plant, the Kansas City Plant, the Savannah River site, Y-12 National Security Complex and other Oak Ridge sites, Hanford, the Trinity Site and Mound Laboratory.) I request these records from the beginning of the Manhattan Project and first opening of Nuclear Weapons facilities in the United States through the present day, so long as these records do not breach National Security. The main basis for the request of this information is in response to the break in at the Y-12 plant by Roman Catholic nun and nuclear activist Megan Rice in 2014. I am requesting information regarding security breaches of a similar nature. I would like to receive the information in electronic format. If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees. As I am making this request as a journalist and this information is of timely value, I would appreciate your communicating with me by telephone, rather than by mail, if you have questions regarding this request. I look forward to your reply within 20 business days, as the statute requires. Thank you for your assistance.
