2. New fee of \$13,165,000 is allocated to the FY2018 Available Fee and is authorized for drawdown as a fixed fee settlement for costs incurred under definitized change orders upon bilateral execution of this modification.
3. A replacement Table B.4-1, "Contract Cost and Contract Fee" reflecting the above revisions will be provided in a subsequent contract modification.
4. Costs, legal and implementation, associated with the Contractor's defense and settlement of Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) case PCHB No. 16-107, are determined to be unallowable and are subject to the Contractor's Statement of Release.
5. Legal costs associated with Federal Engineers and Constructors, Inc. v. CH2M Hill Plateau Remediation Company, No. 4: 15-CV-05036- U.S. District Court, Eastern District of Washington are allowable.
6. Subject to confirmation by Audit, Contractor repayment of \$1,431,541 for the premium portion of training on overtime, with adders, disclosed as of the date of this modification resolves the issue of allowability of disclosed costs.

B. Contractor Statement of Release:

In consideration of this Contract Modification 684, the Contractor hereby waives and releases the Government from any and all liability and responsibility for all claims, causes of action, REAs, and demands of any kind, known or unknown, arising under Contract No. DE-AC06-08RL14788 as of the effective date of this modification. This release includes, but is not limited to the attached list of Change Proposals and Notices of Change on Record.

Pending resolution of external audit or assist audits of the Contractor's proposals:

At the time of this action, external audits of selected proposals contain unresolved issues, and audits of other proposals are pending. Therefore the two parties agree that the negotiated price is subject to adjustment based on the results of the change proposal audit reports, and the results of the applicable annual incurred cost audits. Should there be no agreement on the amount of the price adjustment, then the Contracting Officer may make a unilateral

determination and modify the contract accordingly. Failure to agree with such change and the resulting contract price shall be resolved in accordance with the disputes clause of this contract.
