Employees with Hanford Discount Card (HDC) are eligible to receive the following discounts:

- \$20 off any current enrollment special offered (Example: if our February enrollment special is \$50 off enrollment; HDC holders receive \$70 off enrollment)
 - HDC holders who sign up as a junior/college student, individual or adult+ 1 child are eligible to receive \$10 off their Wellness Plan monthly dues.
 - HDC holders who sign up as a Couple or Family are eligible to receive \$15 off their Wellness Plan monthly dues.
 - HDC holders are also eligible to receive 10% off 1-on-1 personal training sessions and small group personal training sessions.
- *All Wellness Plans are 12-month agreements.
*Hanford Discount Card must be shown at time of sign up to receive discount.

The Hanford Discount Club card is your gateway to savings! Discounts on a variety of items and services, health and beauty products, roadside assistance, even discounts on new and used cars! The only caveat is that you must present your HDC card at the time of purchase.
