

The purpose of this modification is to issue a Change Order in accordance with Clause I-103, Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.243-2, Changes - Cost Reimbursement (AUG 1987). Washington River Protection Solutions LLC (WRPS) is authorized to begin work on the Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant (WTP) Operability Support for Fiscal Year (FY) under Contract Line Item Number (CLIN) 3.2, WTP Operational Readiness Support. WRPS is authorized to begin this work in accordance with the Statement of Work (SOW) provided in Attachment 1 of this modification, with a Not to Exceed (NTE) value of \$2.5M. **Statement of Work (SOW)
Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant (WTP)
Operability Support for Fiscal Year 2015**

The Contractor shall provide support in accordance with Statement of Work Section C.2.3.2 Sub-Contract Line Item Number (CLIN) 3.2: *WTP Operational Readiness Support*.

The Contractor shall identify potential candidates for inclusion in a multidisciplinary team of engineering experts to provide support in completing two tasks with associated deliverables as identified below:

Task 1: Pre-Treatment Focused Operational Support

- a) Planning Area's 2, 3 and 4: Review of Conceptual Designs to support the WTP Senior Technical Design Authority. Design packages will be reviewed and review comments shall be provided to ORP in order to assist in effective oversight and
- b) Pulse Jet Mixing Operability. This includes the review of planning and implementation of Full Scale mixing and testing in support of PT Operability. Test plans, documentation, and sometimes physical observation of tests shall be conducted and review comments provided to ORP in order to assist in effective oversight.

Task 2: Other WTP Support

- a) Respond to review comments on the Draft LAW Design and Operability Report and make adjustments as required.
- b) Develop a concise plan to facilitate the completion of items c, d, and e below.
- c) Review the BNI design processes including the design review process which BNI will provide to ORP. The focus will be on mitigation of previously identified design deficiencies with an operability mindset.
- d) Participate and support ORP in oversight for the LBL Oversight Management Plan.
- e) Provide operational support to DOE engineering in support of risk mitigation including review and recommendations associated with closure of the HLW and LAW Design and Operability issues as well as other project identified issues.

Other deliverables for both tasks shall include review comments and a concise summary report for each quarter of the fiscal year.

Period of Performance: The period of performance for this task begins upon WRPS's receipt of this Change Order modification and ends on September 30, 2015.
