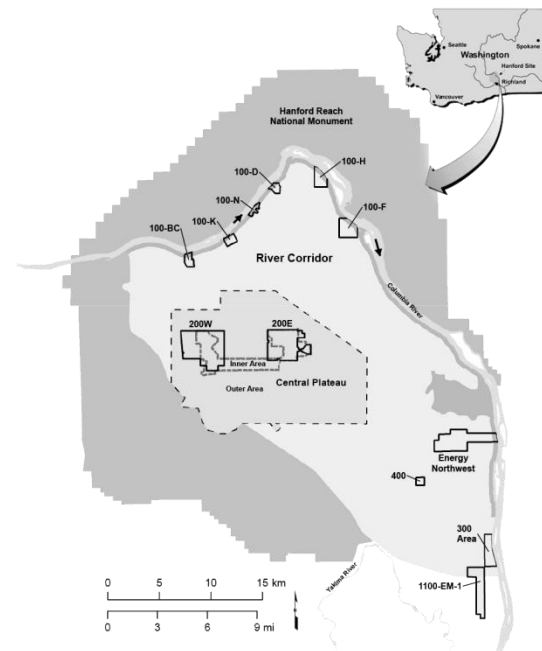


STATE OF THE HANFORD SITE
